Course Description: This intensive course provides the essential refrigeration theory to give registrants an overview of modern industrial refrigeration systems. Provincial regulations require that arena refrigeration plants between 45 - 100 tonne be supervised. Successfully passing this course along with obtaining the Provincial License, satisfies the regulations to have a qualified operator supervise the plant. Registrants are strongly advised to prepare for the course by reviewing the course manual in advance. Also, registrants are strongly advised to become generally familiar with the operation of their refrigeration plant. Registrants will have the opportunity to write the Provincial Refrigeration Operator's Exam to become a licensed Arena Operator in the province.

Course Information: **Course starts at 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Registrants are strongly encouraged to familiarize themselves with their refrigeration system and learn how the system operated. This preliminary work will improve knowledge uptake during the week and for the exam. Lunch is not provided.**
