**Policy name:** COVID-19 Vaccination  
**Effective:** October 12, 2021, to January 1, 2022

The purpose of the COVID-19 Training Vaccination Policy is to mitigate the risks associated with providing safe training environments for our staff, members, and stakeholders. As the leader for the parks and recreation industry that builds healthy active communities, we acknowledge the Province of Saskatchewan's [Public Health Orders](#) as being directly related to providing safe, quality recreation environments.

All participants attending in-person training events, hosted by SPRA, are to be fully vaccinated (as defined by the Government of Saskatchewan). Participants will be defined as those course registrants, facilitators, trainers, and any attending SPRA staff and volunteers. The requirement for proof of vaccination, along with SPRA's use of operating Mitigation Measures strives to create the safest possible opportunities for those who choose to access our services.

In support of this policy, SPRA will require:

- a) All participants, upon arrival for the first day of training, to show proof of [full COVID-19 Vaccination](#) (Government or Saskatchewan Health Authority record) and personal identification for admittance.
- b) Each participant to remove themselves from the training event if answering **YES** to any of the [Screening Questions](#).
- c) Participants who are not fully vaccinated, or answer **YES** to the screening questions, must contact SPRA to determine alternative options. These options may include, and are not limited to:
  - i) Providing proof of a negative COVID-19 test result, from an [approved provider](#), from within the previous 72 hours.
  - ii) Virtual offerings.
  - iii) Future offerings at different locations.
  - iv) Access to complimentary information.
  - v) Examination challenges.

#### Notes:

- No personal medical information will be collected or stored by SPRA.
  - Alternative options are made available based on capacity of SPRA to support and may change without notice.
  - Facilities where events are hosted may have additional requirements for entry.
  - SPRA will only host training events in communities/facilities with complimentary operating policies.
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
