2019 SPRA Conference and Annual General Meeting Student Assistance Program

Purpose

The purpose of the 2019 SPRA Conference and Annual General Meeting (AGM) *Student Assistance Program* is to provide financial assistance for post-secondary students in Saskatchewan to attend the SPRA Conference and AGM.

Funding Guidelines

Eligible students are entitled to receive financial assistance in the amount of 75% of the Student Conference Registration Fee. The student cost to attend the full event (not including the Pre-Conference Events) is \$135.00 (plus GST). Students who receive support through the Student Assistance Program will receive reimbursement from SPRA in the amount of \$101.25 (plus GST).

Funding for eligible students during any particular Conference year will be limited to ten (10) students.

Payment Verification/Follow-up

Participating students are required to submit a follow-up report outlining the benefits the student acquired while attending the SPRA Conference and AGM. This report is to be submitted to SPRA by **Friday, November 1, 2019**. Upon approval and receipt of the follow-up report, eligible students will receive their financial assistance in the form of a cheque from SPRA.

Funding Criteria

The Applicant:

- Will be evaluated on:
 - How attendance at the SPRA Conference and AGM would be significant to the student's personal, academic and professional development.
 - The student's professional goals in the parks and recreation field and what they hope to accomplish as a parks and recreation professional.
 - The student's summary of any volunteer experience related to the parks and recreation field.
 - The student's most recent post-secondary academic class schedule.
- Must be a member of the Saskatchewan Parks and Recreation Association.
 (Note: Student membership is free and a link to the Associate Membership Application Form is provided on page 3).
- Must express an interest in the parks and recreation profession.
- Must be a full-time student in the area of recreation at Saskatchewan Polytechnic, the University of Regina or the University of Saskatchewan.
